Olympia Treasures and History

The ruins of ancient Olympia, dedicated to Zeus and located at the south-western foot of Mount Kronios are a 'must see' sight when visiting the port of Katakolon. A French team partially excavated the Temple of Zeus in 1829, and from 1975 to the present day, The German Archaeological Institute continues to excavate the site. Olympia was one of the most religious and athletic centres in Greece and it is here that the Olympic Games were originally held, every four years, to honour Zeus. Highlights of your visit to Olympia include: The Altis – the sacred enclosure and sanctuary of Zeus, The Classical Temple of Zeus, The Temple of Hera, The Nymphaion, Outside the Altis: Greek Baths, Roman Hot Baths, The Priest's Residence, The Leonidaion and The Roman Hostels. At the end of the tour, the coach can drop you off in the town to explore Katakolon, where there are plenty of souvenir shops bars and cafeterias, before you board your cruise ship.
